COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOLS

The Pembina Trails School Division is committed to the concept of the community use of schools.

While the Board encourages the widest possible usage of Division's facilities by not-for-profit groups and organizations within the immediate community, the requirements of any school shall receive first priority when there are multiple requests for the use of any school building or grounds.

The Pembina Trails School Division will not provide space in any of its schools to:

- any private school
- any organization that duplicates the educational services provided by the school division, where the
 expected participants are of school age
- any organization that has their own facilities.

The Board may lease all or portions of non-operational schools to private schools or other types of organizations when the space is not required for Division use.

In general, regulation KFB-R shall govern the community use of schools.

Where outside organizations are granted use of classroom space, the Board will not provide funds for changes to the space to meet the needs of the user. If the user wishes to fund any modifications, the Board's approval for the modifications must be received before any changes are made.
